Adoption fees include initial set of vaccines, worming, and parasite treatment, rabies vaccine and spay/neuter. Adoption fees will not be refunded after a period of two weeks. Adoption fees start at \$150 and \$175 for puppies 6 months and under. Upon adoption, WCHS relinquishes all responsibilities Of

the adopted dog to the new adoptive owner. WCHS will not be held liable for any personal liabilities or damage to property or financial in debt news's incurred for the care of the adopted animal after adoption.
