Rehoming your pet(s)

If the need to rehome a pet arises, for you or someone you know, the WCHS may be able to help. We offer Private Adoption services via our website. We ask you to email a good photo, information on the pet and your contact number to info@wallowacountyhumanesociety.org. Our webmaster will post it online and any interested party will contact you directly. This is between both parties only, not the WCHS. We also have a wish book at our Center that we will check to see if your pet may be a good fit for someone looking to adopt. We have no shelter and work with foster homes, so we may not be able to take another animal on right away. We ask that you contact us as soon as it is known a new home is needed. Waiting until the last minute often creates a very stressful situation. If the situation changes and the pet doesn't need rehoming, at least everyone was ready.
